Ephesians 2:8-9: "For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast". James 2:17,18: "faith without works is dead [...] I will show you my faith by my works" (2) "I make known to you", "I preached to you", "I delivered to you" (v. 3). All Christians are c_____ to take part in personal e_____, it is your role in the mission of the church: "But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light" (1 Peter 2:9). Jesus was "proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom" (Matthew 4:23) by saying "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand" (Matthew 4:17).
