God Gave Them Up

Romans 1:24-32

The main idea of Romans 1:24-32 is that is that pagan humanity's willful rejection of God and subsequent worship of something else, led God to give them up to their own desires as judgment, which manifests as homosexual behavior, which in turn, represents the comprehensiveness of human depravity.

- The Magnitude of Sin –vs 28 thru 32

Yet you have forsaken me and served other gods; therefore I will save you no more. Go and cry out to the gods whom you have chosen; let them save you in the time of your distress." (Judges 10:13-14)

And the LORD said to Samuel, "Obey the voice of the people in all that they say to you, for they have not rejected you, but they have rejected me from being king over them." (1 Samuel 8:7)

"The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately sick; who can understand it?" (Jeremiah 17:9)

Put to death therefore what is earthly in you: sexual immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry." (Colossians 3:5)

"You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might." (Deuteronomy 6:5)

"What comes out of a person is what defiles him. For from within, out of the heart of man, come evil thoughts, sexual immorality, theft, murder, adultery, coveting, wickedness, deceit, sensuality, envy, slander, pride, foolishness. All these evil things come from within, and they defile a person." (Mark 7:20-23)

"When used simply, it reflects the unity of our inner being, and when used comprehensibly, it describes the complexity of our inner being – as composed of mind (what we know), desires (what we love), and will (what we choose)." Craig Troxel on the biblical definition of "heart," from With Your Whole Heart, Orienting Your Mind, Desires, and Will Toward Christ All humanity is under the righteous judgment of God, who has turned us over to our sinful desires. Nobody is immune. But there is hope. There is a solution - God sent his only Son to deal with this, through his life, death and resurrection.
